- Train ACR staff and volunteers to be volunteer facilitators.

- Iterate our new 1500 sq. ft. volunteer space to maximize volunteer productivity and comfort
- Create outreach materials and campaigns to promote volunteer opportunities
- Create meaningful volunteer thank yous to keep volunteers engaged and coming back
- Join the ACR team for outreach and tabling opportunities in the community
- Engage in workshops, talks and skill-building programs related to non-profit management, the circular economy and related topics
